This Autumn, the Carers Centre has held different wellbeing sessions ranging from upskilling your digital abilities to reinstating our Inbetweeners Socials group!





The wellbeing café provides a safe and supportive environment in the heart of Madeley High Street. It's supported by a team of wonderful volunteers and local businesses.

Alongside a varied menu at a low cost and some amazing events, you can also find bespoke training and employability programmes for young people with additional needs, adults with disabilities, unpaid carers, people with no fixed address, and anyone in need of support with their mental health and wellbeing.

The café can also provide a free space to facilitate a community group, advice and guidance on health and social care issues, a training kitchen for community groups, and event hire and outside catering.
